Illness Policy

Please respect the other children, staff, and our efforts by keeping your children home when they have a contagious illness. These illnesses include: vomiting, fever of 100.4 degrees or above, diarrhea, pink eye, or anything else deemed contagious by your child's physician. We are always glad to have the children back to daycare once they have been symptom and fever free without the use of Tylenol or Motrin for 24 hours. If you or your child has been exposed to COVID-19, please keep them home until your quarantine period is over or have them tested on the 5th day after last day of exposure. They may return once we have the notice from the health department. If your child is showing symptoms of COVID -19 and you have them tested, please keep them home until you receive the results then we will follow protocols accordingly.
